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## STRIDES TO A HEALTHY ST. MAARTEN

St. Maarten is continuing its national population health survey to assess risk factors for noncommunicable diseases called STEPS Survey\*.

\*This survey is an international survey that is conducted by the Government of Sint Maarten with support from the PAHO/WHO. This same survey is currently being conducted in various other countries in the Caribbean region.

**3,500 households** will be randomly selected and surveyed to collect data on behavioral and biological factors that can increase the risk of noncommunicable diseases like hypertension, diabetes, heart attacks, and cancer.

If your household is selected, participation is critical to help improve our community's health.

Expect a knock at your door between **July 2023 - August 2024.**
