PARLIAMENT OF SINT MAARTEN LIST OF PERMANENT AND AD HOC COMMITTEES OF PARLIAMENT (PT. 2)

In accordance with article 21, paragraph 3 of the Rules of Order, at the beginning of the Parliamentary year, as well as in the first public meeting after a periodic resignation or after a dissolution of Parliament, the President assigns the members to the permanent committees for the investigation of certain subjects and to the committee for petitions, unless Parliament decides otherwise.

All members have the right to participate in the meetings of all committees, only the members of the pertinent committee have the right to vote. For committee meetings the quorum is formed by at least half plus one of the number of factions who are member of the committee and at least half plus one of the number of members

are part of the factions present. Each permanent or ad hoc committee, as well as the committee for petitions, appoints its own chairman and vice chairman from among its members. The Chairperson of the committees are also their reporters.

The Chairperson of each committee reports on the progress and state of affairs of the committee if the President requests such. The meetings of the committees are public; Parliament may decide that meetings of certain committees are allowed to be closed to the public. The committees may decide to invite persons or institutions to provide additional information.

On Thursday, October 10, 2024, in its Public meeting no. 1, the Parliament of Sint Maarten voted on and approved the advice regarding the installation and composition of the Permanent and Ad hoc Committees of Parliament. Subsequently on Tuesday, October 15, 2024 and Wednesday, October 16, 2024, during a meeting of the committees, Members of Parliament voted on the appointment of a chairman and vice-chairman of the respective committees.

There are currently seventeen (17) Permanent and ad hoc committees of Parliament.
