Carnival 2025 is on the horizon!

The festive Carnival season 2025 will run from April 21st, 2025, to May 5th, 2025. To ensure a timely preparation for this year's carnival season for all with a **food truck** who wish to vend along the roadside during the Carnival period can now apply for a carnival vending permit.

Application forms can be picked up at the Department of Economic Licenses on the ground floor of the Government Administration Building, Soualiga Road 1 (Window B) from March 27th, 2025, up to and including April 4th, 2025.

The application deadline is April 4th, 2025.

There is space for 10 food trucks and applications will be processed on a first come, first served basis. Incomplete applications will not be processed until all required documents have been submitted.



The following conditions apply to roadside vending:

1. All roadside Food truck vendors must conform to the predefined designs of the vending structures (see samples below). Your food truck will be inspected beforehand.
2. Nothing may be tied or stuck to the trees or lamp posts at the vending locations.
3. Chopping, cutting, and driving nails in trees and/or placing any type of BBQ grill under or around the trees is not permitted.
4. Food trucks will be allotted a location along the pondside between Fat Boy and Cindy's Rotishop.
5. All Food Trucks and debris must be removed from the vending location within 2 days after the closing of Carnival. The vending location must be left in the state in which it was found, or fines will be levied against the permit holder.
6. Music will only be permitted as of 5 pm until closing and may not exceed a maximum of 75dB.

In accordance with article 21 of the National License Ordinance ("Vergunningslandsverordening"), requests for operating licenses, specifically the location of the establishment, are available for public viewing at the Department of Economic Licenses in the Government Administration Building, Soualiga Road #1, Great Bay, Sint Maarten, for a period of **14 days** after the date of this publication. During this time anyone has the right to object to the granting of the operating license(s) in writing. During **1 week** after expiration of the above-mentioned 14 days, both the applicant and those who have raised objections may review the objections submitted against the request.

Objections must be addressed to the Minister of Tourism, Economic Affairs, Traffic and Telecommunication and can be submitted in hard copy at the afore mentioned address or sent digitally to DELObjections@sintmaartengov.org.
