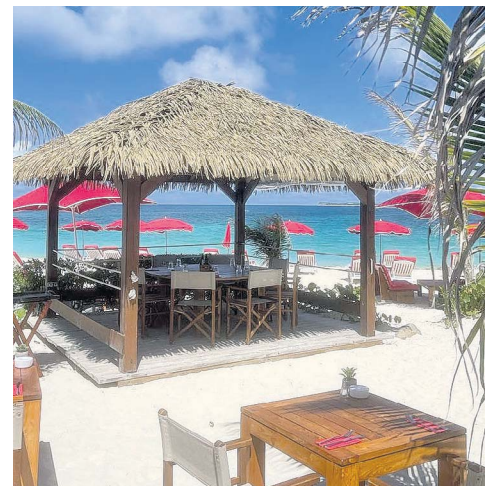

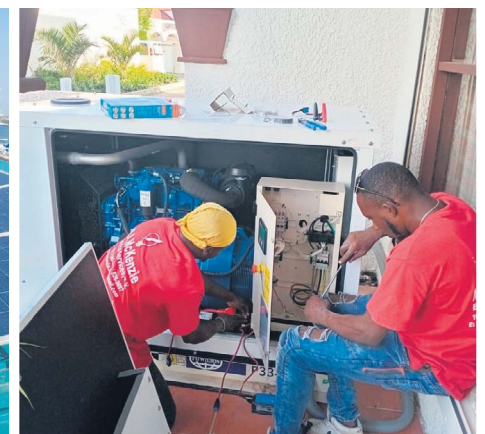

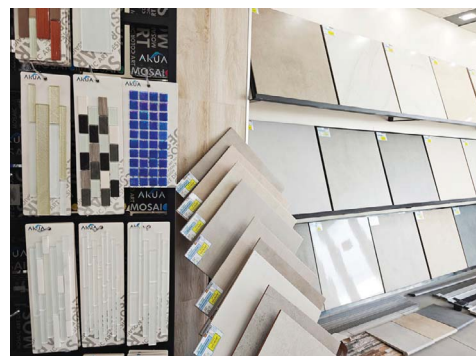

• For mattresses, if you sleep mainly on your back, you'll need one that offers adequate support to maintain spinal alignment. If you sleep on your side, a softer mattress may be preferable to relieve pressure on the shoulders and hips.

• Like a toothbrush, a pillow can't be shared. If you sleep on your back, a flatter

pillow may be preferable to maintain spinal alignment, while if you sleep on your side, a thicker pillow can help free your shoulder and support your head and neck if your mattress is firm. A softer pillow is recommended for less firm mattresses.

• Bonus tip: Silk pillowcases are very beneficial for skin, hair and sleep in general. They are soft, breathable and hypoallergenic. Their effect is recognized on wrinkles, acne and eczema.


